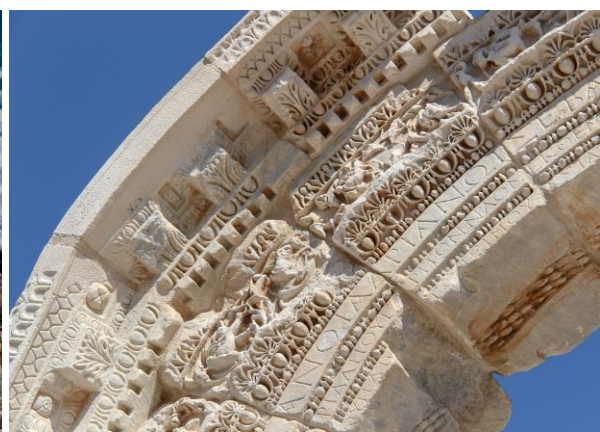
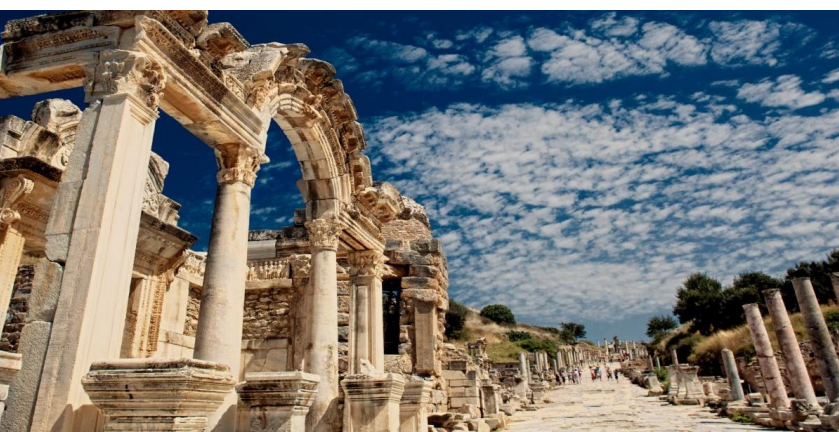

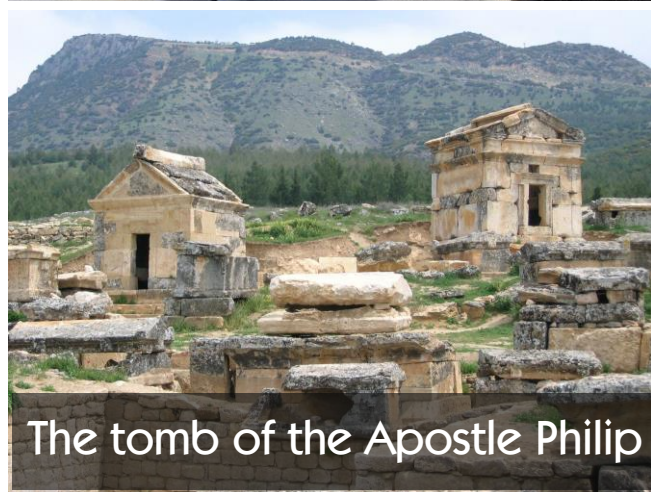

Troy

The Trojan Horse Massacre. The Trojan War in the works of the poet Homer is centered on this city. The famous movie prop Trojan Horse is a landmark of the city.



ASSOS

The Ancient City of Assos | Acts 20:13-14

Leaving Ephesus in January 56, Paul came to Miletus at the end of April 57. He had his last meeting with the elders of Ephesus there. Luke used only sixteen verses to depict this journey. Walk on this ancient road in person and feel Paul's ups and downs.

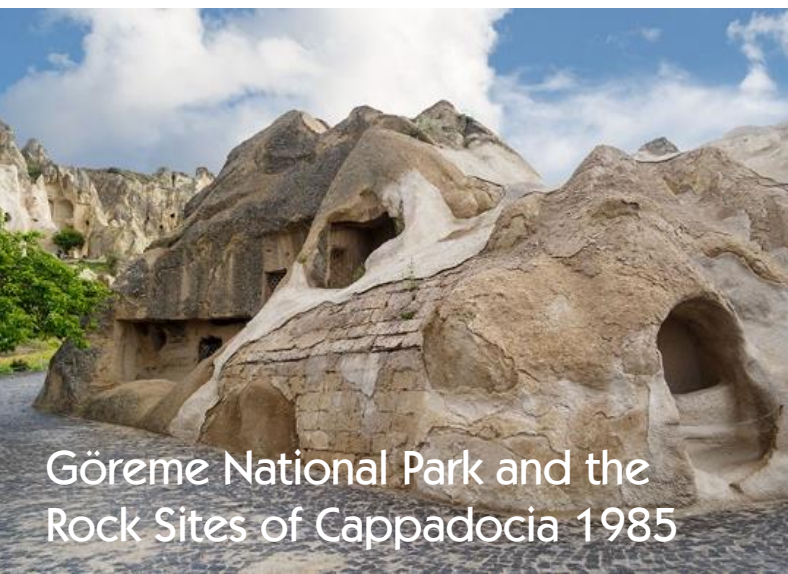

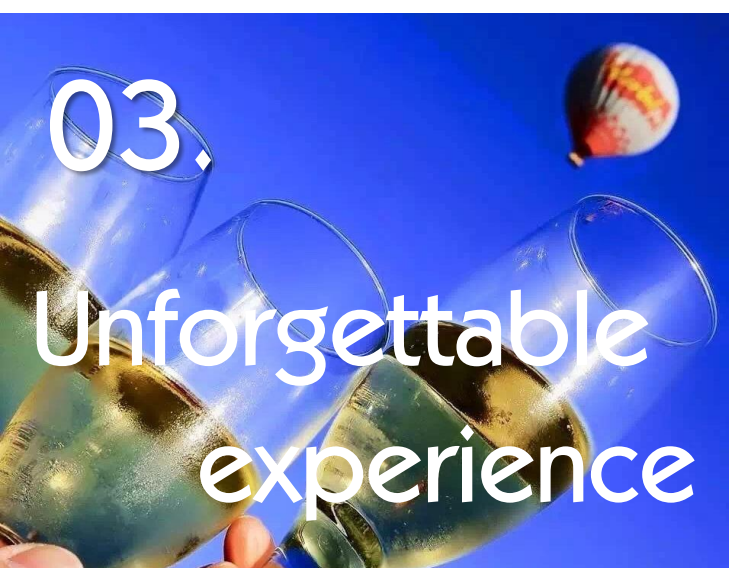

Fee includes:

1. 11 nights boutique accommodation: twin/king bed, hotel as shown in itinerary,
2. Vehicles for the whole journey, including Ferry, entrance fee in the itinerary
3. The tour guide, tour leader and driver will be subsidized for accommodation and meals throughout the journey.
4. Meals included in the itinerary: 1 bottle of mineral water/person/day; 4 person dining in the restaurant, 1 bottle of large mineral water.

Fee does not include:

1. International flight tickets: Airfare to/from IST, Turkey.
2. Visa fee: Turkey visa (our company can handle it)
3. Tip 10 USD/person/day for the tour guide, tour leader and driver (The tour leader will collect 10*12 days = 120 USD / person)
4. Single rooms cost 650 USD more.
(If it is not possible to share a twin room or you need an individual to stay in a single room)
5. Travel Medical Insurance

***The package itinerary starts from Day1 IST airport and ends Day12 IST airport. (Total 11 nights stay)**

Accommodation fees for early arrivals and late arrivals is excluded, additional transfers and accommodation may be purchased.

2. Please pay the balance 40 days before departure.

This offer is valid for prepayment deposit before Jun 10th.

The deadline for registration is Jun 30th.

3. Ten Commanders Project (Team Registration Discount).

Instructions for Group Leaders:

* All related registration forms and payments must be sent by the team leader (The group representative).

* One of the 12 delegates can be free (11+1), the team leader must handle all money and communication.

Please collect your team's expenses and make a **one-time payment**, which can reduce confusion and save on bank transfer fees. Please attach a message to remark your transaction content, **do not** let your group members transfer their own money. If individuals transfer money separately, they don't belong to your group.

1. Those who cancel the tour 70 days before will be refunded in full.

2. Those who cancel the tour 46 days to 69 days before, 70% will be refunded.

3. Those who cancel the tour 31 days to 45 days before, 50% will be refunded.

4. Those who cancel the tour 21 days to 30 days before, 30% will be refunded.

5. Those who cancel the tour within 20 days of the departure date will be refunded 0%.

* If you have already applied for the travel permit and flights, when canceling the tour, you must still pay for the relevant fees.
